Telecytology

- 8 year old female Rottweiler presented for an enlarged popliteal lymph node noted two days prior
- Physical examination:
 - affected LN was on the same side as a digit with a swollen nail-bed
 - Simultaneous development of blepharospasm and cloudy appearance in both eyes
- FNA performed of the affected lymph node (Wright's modified preparation) and 28 digital images are sent to a telemedicine provider
- Images are taken at different magnifications with a camera placed over one of the eyepieces

Telecytology

Steps:

- 1. Make a diagnosis, based on the images.
- 2. Identify limitations that are present with a telecytology case such as this one and how to avoid them.
