The Clinical Laboratory is a multivalent veterinary laboratory and a central service unit for the University Animal Hospital, University of Zurich, Switzerland. We provide diagnostic services for companion, farm and zoo animals in hematology, cytology, clinical chemistry, endocrinological and flow cytometrical analyses, urinalysis, serological and molecular diagnostics for about 30'000 samples/year. We are an important partner for the small animal, horse, zoo and farm animal clinics of the University Hospital as well as for private practitioners, Zoos and wildlife parks. The Clinical Laboratory is accredited by the European College of Veterinary Clinical Pathology (ECVCP) and has currently two Residents and two Diplomates.

We are looking for a locum to provide support for our diagnostic service starting from March 2026 onwards for approximately six month. The ideal profile would include ACVP (clin path) or ECVCP board-certified or eligible and either EU or EFTA citizen due to Swiss employment laws. Reports are written in English and most clinicians are happy to discuss cases in English.

Duties:

- Full Diagnostic Service (internal and external submissions): providing cytology reports, review of hematology slides, medical validation of all laboratory results, support and advice laboratory technicians within the daily routine, providing excellent customer service to our in-house clinicians and referring veterinarians
- No emergency service

Conditions of employment:

The candidate will enjoy a wealth of opportunities in an active and highly motivated team and in an excellently equipped academic clinical pathology service and research environment. Pay is based on the university's salary system and dependent on qualifications and working experience. A room on campus is available free of charge.
